



RESIDENTIAL ELECTRIC DELIVERY SERVICE

AVAILABILITY

Available for any Residential Customer for delivery by Company of electric power and energy used for residential purposes. Where a residence and business are combined in one premise, the service classification shall be determined by the predominant electric use at the premise. Service under this schedule is available to any Residential customer regardless of whether that Customer purchases electric power and energy from the Company or from another supplier. For purposes of Delivery Service in situations where the Customer purchases power and energy from a supplier other than the Company, no distinction is made between general service and space heat customers, and this tariff will apply to both general service and space heat customers who choose to purchase energy from another supplier.

NET RATE PER MONTH

Customer Charge

* \$14.00

The Customer Charge contains the cost of metering and meter reading. If any customer taking service under this tariff wishes to take metering service from a third party supplier of metering, the Company will calculate the cost of metering included in the Customer Charge and subtract it from the charge applied each month.

Energy Delivery Charge

* 8.78¢ per KWH for all KWH of electric power and energy delivered to the Customer each month regardless of the source of the electric power and energy delivered.

MINIMUM BILL

The minimum bill shall be the net monthly customer charge.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

Accounts not paid within 21 days of the date of the postmark of the bill shall be considered delinquent.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

(1) Service will be furnished under Company's Standard Rules, Regulations and conditions of Service and the Terms and Conditions of Delivery Service.

(2) Rural Service shall further be subject to special terms and conditions set out on Ill C C No 8, sheets No 15 and 15.1 of this Schedule.

FUEL CLAUSE

The terms of Rider B apply to service under this rate schedule only if the Customer has chosen to purchase power and energy from the Company. The charge per kilowatt hour (KWH) shall be adjusted upward or downward by an amount per KWH as computed by the procedure of Rider B. Except as specified above, all other provisions of the rate shall apply.
