

Applies to Mt Carmel Service Area
OUTDOOR AREA LIGHTING DELIVERY SERVICE

AVAILABILITY

This tariff will be available to any customer in the Company's electric service area who purchases electric delivery service from the Company regardless of whether they purchase electric energy from the Company or from another supplier.

This tariff will also be available to any customer who does not currently purchase electric delivery service from the Company but who is located in the Company's electric service area.

Service provided herein will be for lighting outdoor areas, where the period of lighting is from dusk to dawn, provided:

- (a) customer contracts for service in accordance with Section 4 hereof.
- (b) customer is located adjacent to Company lines from which such service can be rendered.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

(a) Company shall furnish and install on customer's premises an automatically controlled lighting fixture of a type described below or an equivalent fixture in the event a mercury vapor fixture is not available. Such fixture shall be attached to a distribution type wood pole.

(b) All lamps and additional facilities provided by the Company shall be operated and maintained by the Company, and the Company shall be allowed a reasonable time to make repairs and install replacements during regular working hours.

RATE

(a) **Base Charges**

If the customer takes no other electric delivery service from Company, a monthly customer charge of \$4.50 will be assessed in addition to the applicable charges stated herein.

If the fixture can be installed on an existing distribution type wood pole and service can be supplied from an existing overhead secondary circuit on said pole, the monthly charge applicable to such installation shall be as follows:

Base Charges (continued)

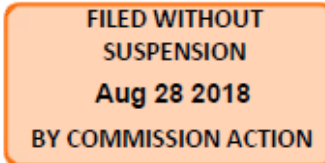
If the Customer purchases energy from the Company, the applicable monthly kwh total shown above will be billed at the applicable monthly Delivery Service Tariff and FAC rate.

If the Customer does not purchase energy requirements from the Company but rather from an alternative supplier, the applicable kwh total above will be utilized for billing delivery service and also provided to the alternate supplier for energy billing purposes.

(b) Additional Charges

In the event additional facilities or rearrangement of existing facilities shall be required to serve Customer, Company shall install, operate and maintain such facilities for the following charge, which shall be in addition to the base charge:

<u>Type of Facility</u>	<u>Charges per Month</u>
30 foot wood pole including 1 normal span of overhead secondary extension.	\$1.46 per pole



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OUTDOOR AREA LIGHTING SERVICE

CONTRACT

Customer shall be required to execute a contract for service hereunder for a term of years determined as follows:

- (a) One year, if additional facilities are not required, or
- (b) Three years, where additional facilities are required.

The primary or extended term of any contract provided for herein shall be automatically extended from year to year with the privilege of either party to terminate the contract at the end of the primary term on not less than ten days' prior written notice or at anytime during any extended term on not less than ten days' prior written notice.

TAX CLAUSE

Bills shall be increased to offset the imposition of any new or increased tax levied by city, county, township or local taxing authority upon the Company's generation, distribution or sale of electric energy or other facilities.

OWNERSHIP OF FACILITIES

All facilities installed by company for service, including fixtures, controls, poles, transformers, secondary lamps and other appurtenances, shall be owned and maintained by Company. All service and necessary maintenance will be performed only during regular hours of the Company. Nonoperative lamps will normally be restored to service within twenty-four hours after notification by the Customer.

GENERAL

Service hereunder is subject to the Rules, Regulations and conditions of Service of Company on file with the Illinois Commerce Commission.
