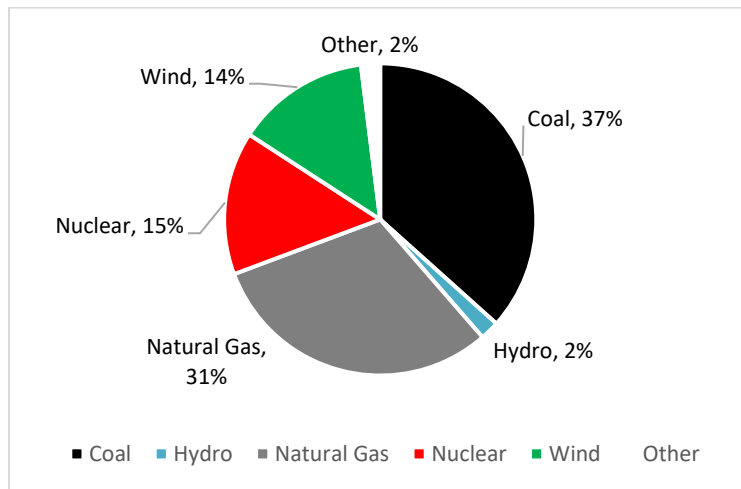


**Important information regarding electricity generation and the environment**
